

Gospel: Matthew 9:1-8

At that time, Jesus got into a boat and went back across the lake to his own town.

Some people brought to Jesus a man who was paralyzed and lying on a mat. When Jesus saw the faith of these people, he said to the paralyzed man, "Be encouraged, young man. Your sins are forgiven." Some of the teachers of the law said to themselves, "This man speaks as if he were God. This is blasphemy!"
