Epistle: Hebrews 11: 33 – 12:2

"A reading of the Epistle to the Hebrews." Brethren: By faith (the Saints) conquered kingdom, did what was just, obtained the promises; they broke the jaws of lions, put out raging fires, escaped the devouring sword; though weak they were made powerful, became strong in battle, and turned back foreign invaders. Women received back their dead through resurrection. Others were tortured and would not receive deliverance, in order to obtain a better resurrection. Still others endured mockery, scourging, even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned, sawed in two, put to death at sword's point; they went about garbed in the skins of sheep or goats, needy, afflicted, tormented. The world was not worthy of them. They wandered about in deserts and on mountains, they dwelt in caves and in holes of the earth. Yet despite the fact that all of these were approved because of their faith, they did not obtain what had been promised. God had made a better plan, a plan which included us. Without us, they were not to be made perfect. Therefore, since we for our part are surrounded by this cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every encumbrance of sin which clings to us and persevere

in running the race which lies ahead; let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, who inspires and perfects our faith.

Gospel: Matthew 10: 32-33, 37-38, 19: 27-30

The Lord said to his disciples; Whoever acknowledges me before men I will acknowledge before my Father in heaven. Whoever disowns me before men I will disown before my Father in heaven. Who ever loves father or mother, son or daughter, more than me is not worthy of me. He who will not take up his cross and come after me is not worthy of me. Then it was Peter's turn to say to him: "Here we have put everything aside to follow you. What can we expect from it?" Jesus said to them: "I give you my solemn word, in the new age when the Son of Man takes his seat upon a throne befitting his glory, you who have followed me shall likewise take your places on twelve thrones to judge the twelve tribes of Israel. Moreover, everyone who has given up home, brothers or sisters, father or mother, wife or children or property for my sake will receive many times as much and inherit everlasting life. Many who are first shall come last, and the last shall come first.

ALL SAINTS OF UKRAINE

The Ukrainian Catholic Church has designated this Sunday, June 15th, to commemorate all the holy men and women of the Ukrainian nation who have heard the call of Christ to be disciples and followed. This is from the earliest days of accepting Christianity. Saint Olha was the first regent (ruler) of the ancient Kyivan state to be baptized. But it was not until the rule of St. Volodymyr the Great, Prince of Kyiv, that all the people of Rus-Ukraine were baptized in the Dnipro River. Two brother princes, Saints Borys and Hlib, sons of Volodymyr the Great, chose to pursue “a life of holiness.” Unlike the other brother princes who were interested in land acquisition. Princes Borys and Hlib made the supreme sacrifice – remaining FAITHFUL TO Christ and His Gospel message of Love and Truth. They are the earliest recognized martyrs of Our Church. Years later, Saint Josaphat would die a Martyr for the Union. In 1596, the Union of Brest was signed with the Church of Rome. At that time Our Church was able to maintain the traditions and rites particular to us, Ukrainian Catholics., and be recognized as an Eastern Catholic Church in union with the Vicar of Peter, the Pope of Rome. St. Josaphat died shortly afterwards on November 12, 1623. He sought to bring all our Christian brethren into one united church. In recent times, Pope Saint John Paul II had beatified numerous confessors of the Faith and martyrs who suffered under Soviet rule. Sister Josaphata Hordeshevska, a Sister Servant of Mary Immaculate was also among those beatified. Pope Francis had named the Servant of God Andriy Sheptytsky “venerable,” worthy of our prayers for his beatification and canonization. With the ongoing invasion and destruction of persons, property, and livelihood by neighboring Russia, there are countless number of Ukrainian Catholics who daily bear witness to the Faith and live a life of Love of God and neighbor. May

we all hear Our Lord's call to holiness. May all the holy men and women of Ukraine who have throughout the centuries faithfully followed Christ inspire us to do likewise.
