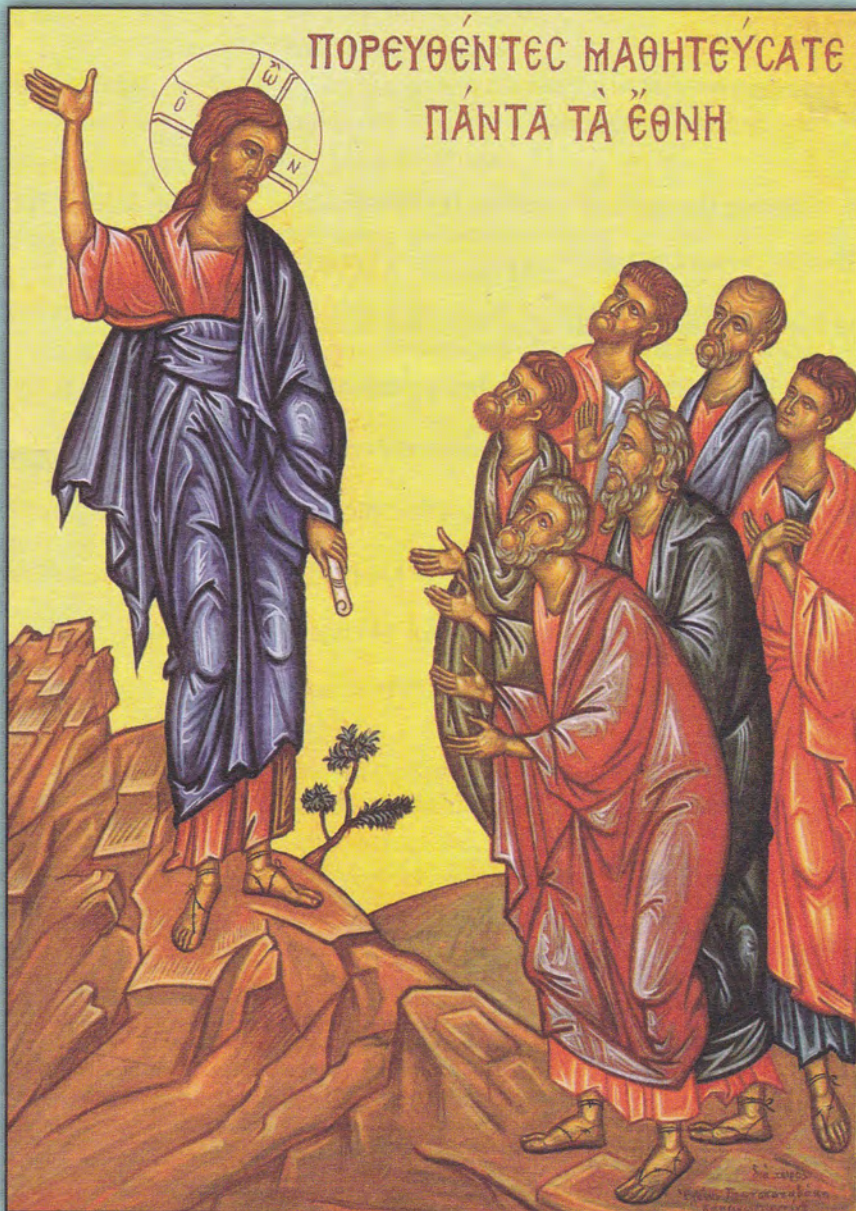

Due to him being on immunosuppressant medication he will need to abstain from weekend Divine Liturgy and communion for a minimum of 3 months, please note he can't give hugs or kisses as well so please don't think it's the cold shoulder. Our family is eternally grateful for all the love, prayers, and support from our parish, we truly could not have gotten through this without all of you. 'Look at the birds of the air,' says Jesus. What a splendid example for our faith to follow!
