### 4. HIS BEATITUDE SVIATOSLAV: THERE ARE NO RELIGIOUS REASONS TO AVOID VACCINATION

"Vaccination is one of the possible ways to prevent the spread of the disease. We must take care of the lives and health of ourselves and our neighbors." His Beatitude Sviatoslav, the Father and Head of the UGCC said, answering questions about the acceptability of vaccination. He noted that very often people have their own ideas and superstitions that have nothing to do with religious life. "Obviously, the safety or effectiveness of the vaccine is within the competence of physicians. When it comes to the perception of vaccination as a phenomenon, there is no religious reason to avoid it."

5. 29TH WORLD DAY OF THE SICK ON FEBRUARY 11, 2021

Pope Francis urges a path of healing grounded in a trusting and interpersonal relationship between the sick and those who care for them. "A society is all the more human to the degree that it cares effectively for its most frail and suffering members, in a spirit of fraternal love." Pope Francis makes the point in his message for this year's World Day of the Sick. In order to fight hypocrisy and self-idolatry, he says, Jesus asks us to "stop and listen, to establish a direct and personal relationship with others, to feel empathy and compassion, and to let their suffering become our own as we seek to serve them." Pope Francis says that the annual day "is an opportunity to devote special attention to the sick and to those who provide them with assistance and care both in healthcare institutions and within families and communities." He expresses his spiritual closeness and the Church's loving concern for those suffering the coronavirus pandemic, especially the poor and the marginalized.
