1. PRAYER FOR INDEPENDENCE DAY

2. SAVE PAVLYK MOTYCHKA DRIVE CONTINUES

Pavlyk Motychka was born in September 2019 in Zakarpattya, Ukraine. He has been diagnosed with Spinal Muscular Atrophy which is degenerative and causes weakness in all the muscles of the body. It affects a Child's ability to crawl, walk, sit up, eat and breath. There is no treatment available in Ukraine. However, an innovative medicine was developed in the U.S. by Novartis. It is the most expensive medicine in the world, costing \$2.3 Million a bottle, and has to be injected into the patient by the age of 2. His family has already lost an older son due to the same disease and is asking for help to save Pavlyk. Here at St. Vladimir's, we have raised \$300 so far. Please, help this little boy. 3. 20TH ANNIVERSARY OF POPE'S VISIT TO UKRAINE

Currently, Ukraine is commemorating the 20th anniversary of the visit of Pope John Paul II. The pontiff visited Lviv and Kyiv at the invitation of the government and Catholic hierarchs of Ukraine. During his stay in Ukraine, John Paul II honored the victims of Bykivnia and Babyn Yar, celebrated four liturgies (two in Latin rite and two in Byzantine), and delivered 11 sermons and speeches. Approximately 200,000 people participated in various events and services held in Kyiv. In Lviv nearly 2 million people attended, including participants from neighboring Poland.

They Marveled and Glorified God

Do you see how He is shown to be Creator of both souls and bodies? He heals the paralysis in both soul and body. The healing of the soul is made evident through the healing of the body, even while the body still remains a creature crawling on the ground. The crowds were slow to recognize who He was: "When the crowds saw it, they were afraid, and they glorified God, who had given such authority to humans." ... He proceeded by His daily actions to arouse them and lift up their thinking. It would have been no small thing for Him to be thought greater than all others, as having come from God. If they had established this adequately in their own minds, they would have known in due order that He was indeed the Son of God.

But they did not grasp these things clearly. Because of this they did not come close to recognizing who He was. For again they were saying, "This man is not from God! How can this man be from God?" Their minds churned over these statements continuously. Which thing many now also do; and thinking to avenge God, fulfill their own passions, when they ought to go about all with moderation. For even the God of all, having power to launch His thunderbolt against them that blaspheme Him, makes the sun to rise, and sends forth the showers, and affords them all other things in abundance; whom we ought to imitate, and so to entreat, advise, admonish, with meekness, not angry, not making ourselves wild beasts.

St. John Chrysostom
