

8. UKRAINE'S HOLODOMOR TO BE COMMEMORATED NEXT SATURDAY

On Saturday, November 27th, the Ukrainian American community will commemorate the 88th anniversary of Ukraine's Holodomor Famine-Genocide of 1932–1933 with a solemn requiem service in New York City. The ecumenical prayer service to remember and honor the millions of innocent victims of one of the worst tragedies that befell the Ukrainian nation, will be concelebrated by the Ukrainian Orthodox and Ukrainian Catholic religious hierarchies at 1:00PM at St. Patrick's Cathedral - 5th Avenue between 50th & 51st Streets.

9. PATRIARCH SVIATOSLAV TALKS WITH THE POPE ABOUT THE PROBLEMS OF UKRAINIAN SOCIETY

November 11, in an audience with Pope Francis, His Beatitude Sviatoslav spoke about the pastoral service of the UGCC in the context of the pandemic and the main current challenges and problems of Ukrainian society. According to the UGCC Information Department, attention was paid to the humanitarian situation in Ukraine in the context of the pandemic. His Beatitude Sviatoslav told the Pope that "the modern post- Soviet space lives in conditions when the rich become even richer and the poor even poorer. A small oligarchic group is being enriched by destroying small and medium-sized businesses, in fact, the middle class is disappearing, the impoverishment of the people is happening at a rapid pace, people are afraid of winter, prices are rising. The energy war that is being waged against Ukraine adds special aggravation. These difficulties are superimposed on the problem of the war in eastern Ukraine, which has not stopped since 2014."
